ABOUT US

The Sleeper/Stoutland Volunteer Fire Departments were established in 1985 and 1973 respectively, though some form of them existed for decades before that.

As of June 2024, the SSVFD has one fire chief, one deputy fire chief, two assistant fire chiefs, one public information officer/assistant chief, one captain, one lieutenant, one safety officer, one senior firefighter, three firefighters, one reserve firefighter, and two auxiliary members. While this sounds like a lot of people, it's not. We desperately need more volunteers! The departments have two stations, two brush trucks, two tankers, three engines, one rescue truck, and one command truck.

The SSVFD responds to an array of emergency calls, including but not limited to: natural cover fires, structure fires, vehicle fires and extrication, lost children and adults searches, fire alarms, helicopter landing zones, and assisting with natural disasters. We also provide mutual aid and support to all surrounding fire departments/districts.
